

Easton, Maryland, was named "Best Small Town Cultural Scene" by USA Today. Easton is an arts and cultural center with a population 16,500+ individuals who love living in a small town that offers the best of many worlds: access to large metropolitan areas like Baltimore, Annapolis, Washington, and Wilmington; good health care from a strong local hospital and medical community; casual and gourmet dining; shopping for all budgets from collectibles to fine antiques; eclectic art galleries; several public golf courses; the splendid Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries in their backyard for sailing, canoeing, kayaking, and crabbing; a historic Town Center with Colonial and Victorian architecture; and an active local community that welcomes new ideas and enthusiasm.



Discover the History Easton's vibrant history features a significant Colonial footprint and a wealth of 18th- and 19th-century architecture. When the Quakers arrived in 1682, they constructed the Friends Meeting House — now one of the oldest churches in the United States. By the late 1700s, the town had grown so large that Maryland's legislature authorized construction of a courthouse, at which time Easton was deemed the "Colonial Capital of the Eastern Shore." Today, researchers are actively investigating "The Hill," a historically free African American community that scholars believe will prove to be the oldest in the nation still in existence.

Explore the Town Stroll through Easton, and you might get the feeling you're strolling through the set of It's a Wonderful Life. But Bedford Falls has nothing on Easton! Explore art galleries at every turn, shop highend boutiques, and dine in gourmet restaurants. Seek inspiration at the Academy Art Museum, then catch a comedy show, concert, or classic film at the Avalon Theatre. Search for your roots at the Talbot Historical Society, which houses more than 10,000 artifacts, a document archive, and a vast photo collection, For added excitement, visit during one of our many festivals, such as Plein Air Easton and the Waterfowl Festival.





Get Back to Nature If the great outdoors are what you're looking for, Easton has plenty to offer. The Pickering Creek Audubon Center offers more than 400 protected acres of forests, wetlands, and wildlife. Following a day of hiking, bird watching, and even canoeing the marsh, set out for a scenic bike ride—there are designated routes for cyclists of all levels. For a nautical adventure, explore the Tred Avon River by sail, paddle, or motor. Or if you're looking to practice your swing, pack your clubs and hit the links. Easton claims two of the county's three championship golf courses.
